### **Lifetime Achiever Award:**

This award is presented to an experienced individual with an extensive and outstanding contribution to the South African film and television industry, both locally and internationally.

### **Youth Achiever Award:**

This award is presented to a young individual who has demonstrated excellence in their craft. Recipients of this award must be below the age of 35 years.

### **Outstanding Person with Disability Contributor Award:**

This award is awarded to a person with a disability who has achieved excellence in the film and television industry.

### **Outstanding Provincial Contributor Award:**

This award is awarded to an outstanding individual, group or a particular initiative that has contributed significantly towards developing the film and television industry in a respective province.

### **Emerging Filmmaker Award**

This award is awarded to a “new-comer” in the film and television industry that is creating or producing brilliant work.
